WHO



The vaccine will be released in 3 phases. Find what phase you're eligible for below.

Phase 1a- Healthcare personnel. Long term care facility residents
Phase 1b- Frontline essential workers. All individuals aged 75+
Phase 1c- All people aged 65-74 years old. individuals aged 16-64 with
underlying medical conditions. Other essential workers.
Phases 2 and 3- Everyone. Determinate qualifications have yet to be set.



WHEN



- After registration (steps listed below), one can expect to wait 1-10 days to receive the vaccine.
- · Vaccination process takes around 20 minutes
 - o For Johnson and Johnson vaccine 1 dose is needed
 - For Pfizer and Moderna vaccinations 2 doses are needed
 - Pfizer requires a second shot 21 days after initial dose
 - Moderna requires a second shot 28 days after initial dose



WHERE



Your county's website (i.e. LA county) will search for the nearest location to you when you register. Locations may include the following: CVS, Rite Aid, Walgreens, hospitals, clinics, other healthcare facilities. Community vaccination sites (i.e. Dodgers stadium, other large spaces).



HOW



Register on your county's website.

Sign up for an appointment online.

• See back of page for more info on your county. Visit the vaccine distribution center at your scheduled appointment time.

Schedule an appointment to receive a second dose, if required.

WHY

Vaccine protects you from COVID-19, may help keep you from getting seriously ill even if you do get COVID-19. It may also protect people around you, particularly people at increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19.
